Cooperative Grocery Stores, Produce Markets, Community Supported Agriculture (CSA), U-pick & Pre-pick Farms

It is always a good idea to **call ahead**. Some of these farms are open to the public whereas other farms are at a family's residence. In addition, the **availability** is always changing. Some of the CSAs still have openings for 2009, while others are taking applications for next year. All of these listings are **within 20 miles of Portland**. Some of the CSAs outside of Portland have pick-up locations within Portland. What is Community Supported Agriculture?

Community Supported Agriculture, or a CSA, is a way for the food-buying public to create a relationship with a farm. A community of individuals pledge to support a farm operation so that the farmland becomes, either legally or spiritually, the community's farm. The growers and consumers provide mutual support and share the risks and benefits of food production. By making a financial commitment to the local farm, people become "members" (or "shareholders", or "subscribers") of the CSA. Most CSA farmers prefer that members pay for the season up-front, but some farmers will accept weekly or monthly payments. Some CSAs require members to volunteer a small number of hours on the farm during the growing season. Other CSAs give additional discounts for volunteering on the farm. By pledging in advance, the CSA members cover the anticipated costs of the farm operation and the farmer's salary. In return, they receive "shares" in the farm's bounty throughout the growing season, as well as satisfaction gained from reconnecting to the land and participating directly in local food production. CSA members receive weekly or monthly baskets full of any sort of different farm products from produce, flowers, fruits, eggs, milks, or meats. Some CSAs offer ½ shares or ¼ shares, or a shorter season share (e.g. "peak season"). It is also typical for neighbors to share a "share" in order to use the entire basket of goodies, depending on an individual or family's eating habits. A CSA typically runs from late spring through early fall (18-20 weeks). The number of CSAs in the United States has grown from an estimated 50 in 1990, to more than an estimated 3000 in 2009.

How do I purchase local produce?

The farms and CSAs below are organized by area. However, some of the farms outside of Portland metro have delivery or pick-up sites within Portland. Each farm's structure is different varying from: markets on-site at the farm, farm stands near the farm, pick-up sites at various locations for CSA members, online orders, email orders, to purchasing produce at local grocery stores. Some of the farms have U-pick, where you go out into the fields (often with your own containers) and pick the fruit or vegetables you would like. Other farms have pre-pick by order where you call ahead and request what you would like.
